In the first quarter of 2025, LIFE CAP PT II is preparing to host one of the largest national events for the LIFE community.

LIFE CAP PT II, the national capacity building project for the LIFE program, is preparing for the 2nd edition of INTER LIFE PT, scheduled to take place in March 2025, organized by APA, the Portuguese Environment Agency, in collaboration with the other LIFE CAP PT II project partners (DDL, DGEG, IFCN and SRAAC).

National LIFE projects are invited to participate, at the location of the host project's activities, with the aim of sharing their experiences, promoting strong networking and enhancing the construction of partnerships for future projects. Projects coordinated by teams from Italy with national partnerships that were visited in the first good practices exchange held in July 2024 will also be invited. Collaboration, not competition, is the motto that has accompanied all editions of the Portuguese INTER LIFE, and 2025 is expected to be no exception.

There will be 2 days in an informal environment, with easy and genuine sharing of information and experiences, which includes a field visit with a demonstration of the actions of the host project. It is an opportunity to get to know other projects, establish new contacts, and discuss ideas and collaborations. These are just some of the strengths of the event,













highlighted by respondents who participated in the 2024 edition, with more than 87% saying they would repeat this experience. To these and to those who have not yet participated in this event, the LIFE CAP PT II project reinforces the invitation to all ongoing LIFE projects to participate in the next edition of INTER LIFE 2025.
