## **Exchange of Good Practices - Spain**

In October, the LIFE CAP PT II Project will conduct its second visit for best practice exchange between national contact points, this time in Spain.

The visit will include both room sessions and field visits to projects ongoing under Spanish coordination, some with Portuguese partners. The goal is to exchange experiences on critical topics for LIFE projects identified within the scope of the LIFE CAP PT II Project, as well as to promote the use of this Program in both countries.

The final meetings of the Portuguese and European Advisory Boards and the Portuguese Stakeholder Board will take place in the last quarter of this year.

The Advisory Boards are composed of entities responsible for implementing policies or linked to LIFE's areas of intervention, with the mission of advising the Project through the exchange of technical knowledge and the identification of complementary solutions.













The Stakeholder Board is composed of groups or organizations (potential beneficiaries of LIFE funding) that can help disseminate this Program.

This is the moment for the Project to report on its activities to these two Boards, encouraging the sharing of ideas and suggestions for the continuous improvement of its activities.

### LIFE PORTUGAL Podcast

The LIFE CAP PT II project is nearing completion, and the 24-episode podcast series outlined in its communication plan already has 16 published episodes. December will mark the final stretch of this informative format for all those interested in the LIFE Program.

Its goal is to increase communication and third-party involvement in critical LIFE issues, such as the relationship with sectoral policies or project replication.
