INTER LIFE PT 2026 - Évora

The 5th edition of **INTER LIFE PT**, the largest national meeting dedicated to the **LIFE Programme** community, will take place on **March 24th and 25th 2026**, at the **University of Évora**, the host institution for this edition. The event is promoted by the **LIFE CAP PT II Project**, which mission is to strengthen national capacity building for the LIFE Programme and support the creation of projects in the areas of environment and climate, including energy.

INTER LIFE PT once again brings together projects, management entities and beneficiaries of the LIFE Programme, in a privileged moment for **sharing experiences**, **disseminating results**, **networking** and **establishing strategic partnerships**.

The 2026 edition introduces the participation of projects coordinated by Spanish entities and the Spanish National Contact Point (NCP), expanding Iberian cooperation and promoting cross-border synergies that strengthen the capacity and impact of the LIFE Programme in the Iberian Peninsula.

The event will include thematic sessions, dedicated project presentations, and opportunities for interaction between teams, in a collaborative environment that facilitates the development of new project ideas and networking proposals.

Closing Session

The **LIFE CAP PT II Project**, funded by the European Union's LIFE Programme and dedicated to strengthening national capacity for the development and implementation of LIFE projects, will hold its official closing event in **Évora** in **March**. This session, which will take place back-to-back with INTER LIFE PT 2026, will bring together, in addition to the LIFE community with ongoing projects, representatives from public entities, civil society organizations, companies, universities, and national and international experts.

Throughout the meeting, the main results achieved during the project's execution will be presented. The project's mission was to strengthen skills, promote access to this European funding, and support the preparation of applications in the areas of **environment** and **climate action**.

The conclusion of LIFE CAP PT II marks the end of another significant stage of this Program in Portugal, but leaves behind a legacy of tools, skills and collaborative networks that will continue to strengthen national capacity in the environmental and climate field.
