

## Diretiva Single-Use Plastics (SUP)

De acordo com o n.º 5, do artigo 97.ºA do [UNILEX](#), a partir de 1 de julho de 2021, a APA, I. P., publicita os resultados de gestão alcançados a nível nacional para cada fluxo específico de resíduos, até cinco dias úteis após a validação pela Comissão Europeia do reporte previsto.

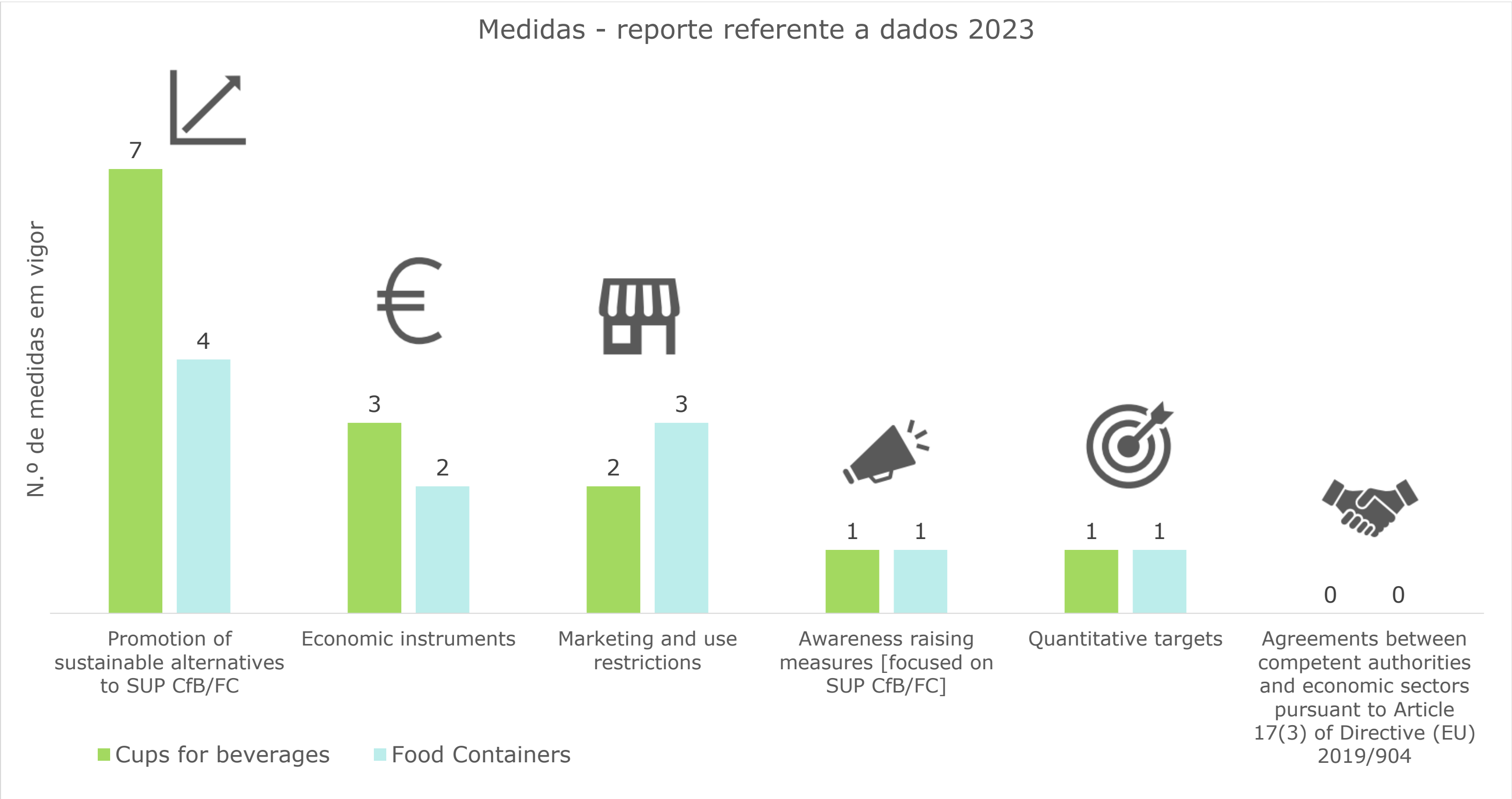

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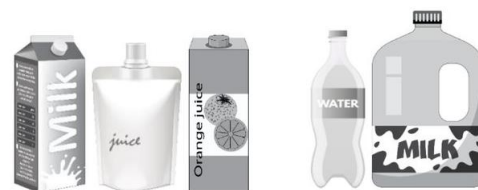

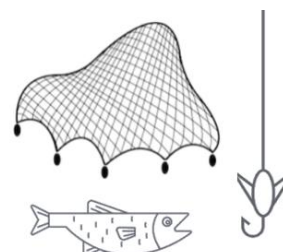

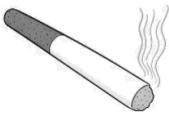
